2 Product Definition

2.1 Functions at a glance

An ETAS INCA Service Pack (SP) is one single ZIP file containing

- Latest version of INCA V7.3 and the most important related INCA Add-ons
- Installation routine, which automatically installs/updates INCA and the INCA add-ons already installed on the user's PC (and shipped with the current INCA Service Pack).
- Add-ons, which are not installed on the user's PC, will not be installed / updated automatically but on demand (selection via check box).
 This may also require a valid license key.
- INCA and the INCA add-ons are available in the ZIP as single / separate installations as well. It is still possible to create user / company specific installations if required.

 If an add-on is not installed, it could be installed manually by starting the corresponding installation. But this is no longer recommended. Recommended is to use the Setup_ServicePack to guarantee that all products are updated to the same release level.
- INCA Refreshes, Hotfixes and add-ons will no longer be available on the download page as single downloads.
- INCA Service Packs are be offered for INCA V7.0 and higher
- The Release Notes, What's New, Updated Manuals and Open Source Software Attribution documentation of INCA and the included INCA add-ons are collected in folder "Documentation"

After successful installation of the INCA Service Pack with <code>Setup_ServicePack</code> the complete content of folder "Documentation" is available via Program-Menu -> ETAS -> INCA 7.3 ServicePack or directly on <INCA 7.3 installation path>\Readme\INCA ServicePack.

2.2 General Description

2.2.1 Safety Notice

Calibration activities influence the behavior of the ECU and the systems controlled by the ECU. This may result in unexpected behavior of the vehicle and thus can lead to safety critical situations.

Only well trained personnel should be allowed to perform calibrate measurements activities.

Important: With release of INCA V7.2 SP13.1 the new ETAS Safety Advice is available with the following additional languages: Belarussian, Russian, Ukrainian, Vietnamese, Thai, Traditional Chinese, Indonesian, and Hindi. Please read it carefully.

The ETAS Safety Advice is displayed during start of INCA (Disclaimer) and it is available in $ETAS_Safety_Advice.pdf$ in the folder \Documentation\ReleaseNotes\of the installation package (ZIP file)

or after installation of the INCA Service Pack in

Program-Menu -> ETAS -> INCA 7.3 ServicePack in the folder \ReleaseNotes.

2.2.2 Known Issue Reports

If a product issue develops, ETAS will prepare a Known Issue Report (KIR) and post it on the internet. The report includes information regarding the technical impact and status of the solution. Therefore you must check the KIR applicable to this ETAS product version and follow the relevant instructions prior to operation of the product.

2.2.3 System Prerequisites

Same like the included INCA refresh, hotfix and add-on installations and INCA related SW. See the Release Notes of the corresponding products shipped with the Service Pack.



2.2.4 Software Prerequisites

To update the SW shipped with this INCA Service Pack, the corresponding product has to be installed on the computer. Most of the INCA – add-ons could be installed directly with the Service Pack installer on request, but the DVD/CD of the corresponding product might contain additional tools and documentation.

2.3 Delivery

The software is delivered with an installation routine, software, documentation, tools, utilities, and further information. All software documentation (e.g. the Release Notes of the included ETAS products/add-ons) is available in the Portable Document Format (PDF) in the folder \Documentation, which requires Adobe® Reader®.

2.4 Installation

2.4.1 Installation Hints

Shut down all ETAS SW before updating it with the INCA Service Pack. Otherwise the installation might be incomplete, stop, or the final installation will not run without issues.

Important: After the installation a reboot of the computer system is recommended. Whenever uninstalling INCA, the INCA uninstall program should be used. This ensures that all add-ons and other products installed with INCA are also uninstalled (except ETASData and ETAS License Manager). Never delete files or folders manually. Installation, update to a new or downdate to a former INCA Service Pack version is also recommended with help of the Setup ServicePack.exe.

Important: INCA add-ons (or INCA engineering add-ons) which are not part of the INCA Service Pack has to be updated manually to avoid unexpected behavior. Not updated add-ons might lead to system errors or wrong results.

3.1 Important Note to the Installation valid for each Service Pack

It is recommended to install, update or down date the INCA Service Pack only with help of the Service Pack Installer of each INCA SP (but no manual selection and installation/update of some of the installed products to avoid incompatibilities). Uninstallation only via the Windows control panel – but no manual deletion of files or folders.

- HSP is not included in the INCA Service Pack (exception: INCA 7.3.0 DVD version). Please download HSP from the ETAS download center and update the FW of the used devices.
 - Important: With the every new INCA Service Pack typically also a higher HSP version has to be used. For the corresponding version see the release notes below. Operation of hardware with former firmware version might cause erroneous operation.
- Each of the included installations (add-ons) of the SP is recommended, if the corresponding HW support is required and/or a former version of the add-on was already installed.
- If the products of the SP are installed via Setup_ServicePack.EXE the products are
 automatically installed in the recommended order.
 (Manual installation: The recommended installation order is like the release order (or
 order in the SP), if nothing different is specified in the corresponding readme.txt of the
 add-ons)
- Some installations (like MDF Shell Extension, MIP) cannot be installed automatically, e.g. they require some user input during installation:
 - If you need to install MDF Shell Extension, please execute \MDFShellExtension\MDFShellExtension.exe for manual installation.

Title

INCA/MDA installation fails due to limited disk space during .NET 4.6.x installation

Workaround: The installation of .NET 4.6.x requires min. disk space of 4.5GB before installing INCA or MDA itself. If .NET 4.6.x is not installed, this amount of space is required in addition to the min. required space for the ETAS product installation.

It is recommended to install .NET 4.8.x before the INCA Service Pack installation. Source: Either from Microsoft or from installation the following share on the INCA 7.3 DVD/SP:

01_INCA_V7.3.n\00_Prod_INCA_72n\Packages\3rdParty\DotNet4.8.x Note: Use the latest .Net 4.8.x version shipped with the INCA Service Pack. Reboot the computer after the .NET-installation and before installation of the INCA Service Pack is required.

3.3.2 Known issues and important hints

- After the installation of the INCA Service Pack a reboot of the computer system is recommended. This is also true for hotfix installations.
- #663640 Service Pack Installer: Installation of INCA 7.3 fails with exception.
 During the installation of the Service Pack, it might happen that the Service Pack Installer (SPI) crashes.
 - It is then typically not possible to start the SPI again to continue the installation, as the reboot is requested and pending.
 - Please reboot the computer in such case. Typically, the SPI will then start automatically and finalize the installation. If not, please start the SPI again and select your products, which shall be additionally installed.
- INCA add-ons (or INCA engineering add-ons) which are not part of the INCA Service Pack has to be updated manually to avoid unexpected behavior. Not updated Add-ons might lead to system errors or wrong results.
- Hardware supported free is now integrated into the INCA base installation. No further additional add-on-installation required. See also section "No longer shipped with INCA V7.3" (at the bottom of these release notes)
